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HINDI CLASS SYLLABUS

There are 12 classes each Semester and 3 class levels – Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced. The classes will mainly focused on reading and conversational Hindi with emphasis on learning the rich culture and history of India.

Beginner Level (Ages 5 and Up):

Fall Semester:

1. First five letters; first poem, numbers 1-25
2. 6-10 letters, first poem, numbers 1-25
3. 11-15, first poem, numbers 1-25
4. 16-20, second poem, numbers-125
5. 21-25, second poem, numbers 1-25
6. 26-30, second poem, 5 fruits, 5 animals, body parts
7. 31-35, Shlok, 5 fruits, 5 animals, body parts
8. 36-40, Shlok, 5 fruits, 5 animals, body parts
9. 41-45, Shlok, learn three sentences in Hindi
10. 46-50, practice poems and Shlok, learn three sentences in Hindi
11. 51-52, practice poems and Shlok, learn three sentences in Hindi
12. Parents observe, children sing poems and Shlok

Class Type:

- First 15 minutes: National anthem and discussion of videos
- Next 45 minutes: as above
- Last 15 minute: wrapping up and snack.

Homework: Review classwork and watch assigned two assigned videos.

Beginner Level (Ages 5 and Up):

Spring Semester:

1. Letters just like first semester in each class after “Jana Gana Mana” and discussion of videos.
2. Skit preparation, each person should have at least three sentences to say in the skit.



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Intermediate Level (Prerequisite -Understanding of alphabets a must)

Fall semester:

First fifteen minutes jan gan man and discussion of videos

1. Review of all the letters and numbers 1-25
2. A and AA matra and make 10 words, numbers 26-50
3. A and aa matra, 10 words, numbers 26-50
4. I and IEE matra and make 10 words, numbers 26-50
5. I and IEE matra and make 10 words, learn 5 opposites(upar-neeche; chota-bada, patla-mota etc), poem 1
6. O and oo matra and make 10 words, 5 opposites, poem 1
7. O and oo matra and make 10 words, 5 colors, poem 2
8. Ai and aii matra and make 10 words, 5 colors, poem 2
9. Ai and aii matra and make 10 words, all seasons and weather, shlok
10. Uo nd uoo matra and make 10 words, all seasons and weather, shlok
11. Uo and uoo matra and make 10 words, practice poems and shlok
12. Parents observe, poem and shlok

Homework: Watch assigned video, review class work.

Intermediate Level

Second Semester:

1. Review all letters and matras
2. Make three-five sentences using different matra about a famous person, practice skit
3. Make three-five sentences using matras about same famous person, practice skit
4. Three-five sentences about famous place , practice skit
5. 3-5 sentences about famous place, skit
6. Three sentences about an Indian festival, skit
7. Three-five sentences about Indian festival, skit
8. Three-five sentences about an Indian food, skit
9. Three-five sentences about an Indian food, skit
10. Earth day celebration, Practice skit
11. Practice skit
12. Parents observe, skit



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HINDI CLASS SYLLABUS

Advanced Level:

There will be lot of emphasis on reading and conversational Hindi related to the culture and history of India. The students would need to pick a topic and speak on parents observe day or can make a two person skit per their teacher's advice.
